Regional Collaboration is Key

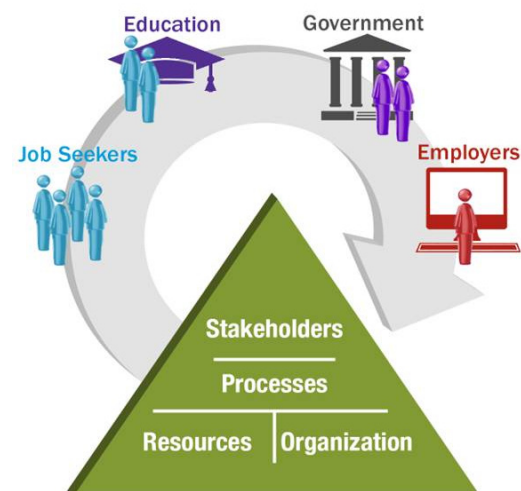

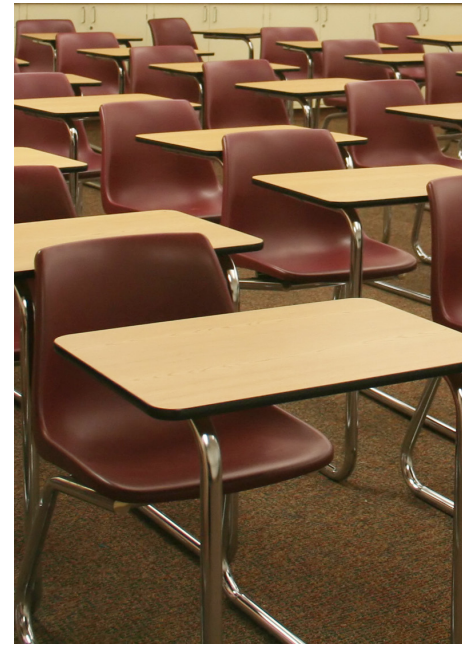
